The following advice from Shropshire CCG about what to tell our patients who are considered as frontline health and care workers:

**Booking process:** Shropshire, Telford and Wrekin Covid-19 Vaccination Service have established a booking process for employers or bodies to register their interest in arranging for frontline health and care staff to be vaccinated.

To register your interest for the vaccine, please email <a href="mailto:shrccg.stwvaccination@nhs.net\_including">shrccg.stwvaccination@nhs.net\_including</a> your organisation name, lead contact name and e-mail address, total workforce population and eligible frontline health and social care worker population so that we can contact you to advise on the process for your frontline staff to book their vaccine.

**Please note,** individuals need to check with their employer to ensure they have registered their organisation and that they are on the employers list of frontline health and social care staff eligible for the vaccine. The employer will then distribute communications to eligible employees regarding the process for you to receive your vaccine.

All frontline health and social care staff in Shropshire, Telford and Wrekin are important so we are actively working with partners and stakeholders to ensure they can access vaccination at a venue that is close to them as quickly as possible.

 NB Individuals need to contact their employer and it should be the <u>employer only</u> who contacts the e-mail address to register their organisation - It is NOT a general comms/queries line.

Self-employed workers who meet the definition for cohort 2b can also register their details via this email address.

All frontline health and social care workers directly working, and in regular and close contact with, people clinically vulnerable to COVID-19 who need care and support irrespective of where they work, whether they care for clinically vulnerable adults or children; or who they are employed by.
